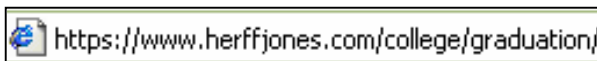


HOW CAN I INSURE THAT HERFF JONES HAS SECURED MY CREDIT CARD DATA?

There are a number of ways to confirm that a secure connection is being used when requesting your personal information (name, address, credit card, etc.) Microsoft Internet Explorer will often display a warning message to alert you when you are entering or leaving a secure connection.



As you move through the initial pages of our site and select products, the URL will read as **HTTP://**. Once you reach the screen where you are asked to enter your name, address and payment information, the URL in the address bar changes to **HTTPS://**. This means that you are currently protected under a secure server.

The best way to determine the security level of any site is through the lock icon located in the lower right portion of your browser window. This icon will appear once you reach the screen where you are entering your name and credit card data. Click on this icon to view detailed information about our security certificate.
